

Presentation Instructions

As a reminder, half of your grade is based on your presentation, and half on the comments you provide to other students.

Before class, post your slides to the appropriate google drive folder. I will send out the link later today on Piazza.

If you are not presenting, you should comment on three of the presentations; I will hand out specific assignments next week.

By the Wednesday midnight following presentations, post comments to the relevant google folder (again, I will send links). Failure to post by this deadline will forfeit credit for this part of the assignment.

Each person or group will have 10 minutes to present, and we'll have 2 minutes for questions. Each presentation day has 7 students/groups. I will randomly assign you to dates.

For the presentation

- tell us an organized story about your data
- using visualizations
- remember to explain the chart or graph
- even good graphs are not self-evidence
- make sure you tell us the point – consider putting it in the title
- make slides for presentation beyond the graphics
- choose your most important visualizations – do not feel compelled to use all of them

For the comments

- perhaps half a page of bulleted comments
- look at the posted presentation to make specific comments on visualizations
- be constructive
- and not too complementary
